

## Materials list for Botanical Watercolor:

Paper: Tracing Paper:  
9x12 or larger (Canson Tracing Calque is good)

Watercolor Paper:  
9x12 or larger pad or block of Arches 140lb Cold Press Watercolor Paper. *It is strongly recommended that you work on this paper for class.*

Small pad of lower quality wc paper for testing color, etc. Strathmore 400 WC paper in a pad or Canson Montvale WC Paper.

Pencils: HB graphite artists pencil and a sharpener

Box of 12 Prismacolor Verithin Pencils

2 Erasers: Kneaded eraser

Ruler: 12" metal or plastic

Brushes: *Brushes make a difference....recommended brands.*

1 Winsor Newton Sceptre Gold Series 101 # 6 round watercolor brush

1 Raphael Kaerell synthetic #6 round watercolor brush

1, #2 or 3 synthetic round with a good point.

Palette: If you have one, bring it. If not, I will provide you with a good beginners palette for \$2.00

Also a white porcelain dish, 6" or larger (thrift shop is a good place to find one very cheap and Target sells individual pieces of Corelle Ware which is very light weight)

*Do not bring plastic!*

WC Paints: We will be using watercolor paints in a tube, not cakes. If you already have tube paints, please bring them, but be sure they are student grade or better. You may purchase student grade (a good price) or the more expensive professional grade paints.....this is totally up to you!

Student grade:

Grumbacher Academy or Winsor Newton Cotman (I think Grumbacher is better)

*Do Not Purchase Reeves Watercolor Paints!*
