# Suggested materials - Figure Drawing for Teens class

### Pencils:

- vine charcoal and charcoal pencils (soft, medium, hard)
- compressed charcoal 2 grade for darkest blacks (optional)set of at least 60 soft pastels or Eberhard Faber Nupastels (semi-soft) largest set of 96 graphite pencils (2H, H, HB, 2B, optional 4B-8B)

  Cretacolor Nero lead medium for richest blacks (optional)

# Paper:

- acid free white charcoal or pastel paper (texture needs slight tooth to hold charcoal or pastels) acid free light gray charcoal or pastel paper (optional) acid free smooth white drawing paper for graphite newsprint (for studies and padding under good paper) acid free sketchbook (comfortable travel size)

### Miscellaneous:

- kneaded erasersstumns
- stumps chamois for erasing broad areas and subtle shading (optional)

- sandpaper blocks (for sharpening vine charcoal) pencil sharpener hand mirror (optional, but highly recommended)
- plumb line (optional thin dark thread with a washer tied at bottom) narrow knitting needle or skewer (optional for sighting angles)
