

## **Materials list – Collage into Abstraction**

If you already have materials you can bring them to the first class, If you aren't sure what to buy we will cover that in the first class session.

Synthetic bristle brushes for acrylic paint, flats and rounds, your choice of size

Elmer's or white glue

Disposal house-painting brushes for applying colors – 2" to 4"

Rags for clean up, container for putting brushes in water before cleaning in the sink.

You should wear clothing that is okay to get paint on or an apron/smock.

**Collage materials** can include fabric, wallpaper, magazine pictures, cardboard, old paper, brown and color shopping bags, Styrofoam sheets – anything you want to use

**Good quality acrylic paints** such as Utrecht, Liquitex, Winsor Newton, choose colors not pre-mixed with white or other colors;

Hansa (Lemon)Yellow, ultramarine blue, Cadmium Red Medium, titanium white, ivory black, optional colors **include any colors you like**, permanent violet, cadmium orange, chromium green, yellow ochre, raw sienna

Leftover house paints can be used too.

Pointed metal palette knife (2" - 2 ½" blade) for mixing colors

**Very important** - Palette paper pad for mixing paint on – excellent for using dried sheets for collage elements – (any size)
